(My name is [REDACTED])

S: ok

D: Thanks, this was a few years ago, but have you ever heard of the Femichio family?

S: yes, dominick femichio—and his sister bertha dubensky

D: Yes, that is them... Do you know the name Lynda Femichio?

S: dominick's son is tony

Lynda was married to tony

S: lynda was a kerr

D: Yes... I know this is out of the blue, but I would like to ask about Lynda...

D: Do you know this family well?

S: yes, real well—

D: Oh my god, really? So you know Lynda well?

S: i know lynda is a very troubled person, and i don't know how much i can tell you—I need to know—why are you asking?

D: Yes, that is true what you have said about Lynda... I will answer all of your questions... Lynda has been in quite alot of trouble in recent years... do you know that?

S: yes, most everything

D: Do you know where she is now?

S: she has a drug problem—I believe she is still in dubois

D: Actually, she is not in Dubois...

D: She has not been there for a few years...

S: her brother lives in [REDACTED] is working with him right now

D: What business is [REDACTED] in?

S: he is running a strip mine in chantilly, va.

S: my husband is a heavy equipment mechanic

D: Really? Was [REDACTED] ever in an auto business of any kind, do you know?

D: And may I ask how long you have known Lynda?

S: not that i know of... he and his first wife owned a bar in big run, Pa. called little canada

S: i have known lynda since high school—she was one year behind me in school

D: I see... was there also another sybling in that family? Oh, PAHS I think.

S: yes, sister [REDACTED] married to [REDACTED]—lives in york, Pa

D: You must be aware of Lynda's children, Leslie and Melissa?

S: i know she has kids, but i only saw them when she and tony were still together—years ago

D: Was Lynda always someone with troubles? Or did her problems begin later in life?

S: she had problems early in life—and as she got older, they got worse

D: These troubles. We are not talking about just drugs here, am I right?

S: her mother died when she was [REDACTED] and after that, she seemed to have mental problems

S: her mother's sister, was almost my [REDACTED]—back in the early 90's

D: This is an amazing coincidence...

S: why are you so interested in lynda?

D: I was victimized by Lynda in a complex crime she orchestrated.

S: you are just one of many

D: Do you personally know of others..?

S: her husband [REDACTED]—went to jail because of her

D: I did some research... are you referring to the [REDACTED] incident?

S: she stole payroll check from there, and cashed them—if you know about [REDACTED] then you should know the whole story

D: No I just know what I read in a small article from the Punxsy spirit I was able to pull up... I don't know much about that situation.

S: then she stole drugs from both hospitals in dubois, then she worked as home health nurse, and stole from the people that were her patients

D: I didnt know Lynda was behind it.//// Was she arrested or were there criminal charges associated with her misdeeds?

S: by the way, my husband works for [REDACTED]—17 years, we were around when it took place—i was the one who started them looking into it, because another guy involved told me things, and i told the owners, after that, it was history

D: Lynda orchestrated the crime but [REDACTED] took the fall?

S: what the story was, [REDACTED] stole to keep up with her life style. she ran up the credit cards, bought stuff that he couldn't afford.

D: She manipulated him... How much time did [REDACTED] serve?

S: he was a really nice guy—I have know him since in the early 60's

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“I know Lynda is a very troubled person”

“She has a drug problem”

“She had problems early in life – and as she got older, they got worse”

“She seemed to have mental problems”

“She stole payroll checks – and cashed them”

“She stole drugs from both hospitals in Dubois”

“She worked as home health nurse, and stole from the people that were her patients”

S [redacted] I was in [redacted] in Alabama at the time--I do believe it was [redacted] years-- grand theft-- [redacted] dollars

D [redacted] Was the money ever accounted for and returned? And has [redacted] reestablished himself as "respectable" member of society?

S [redacted] the main guy was Harry [redacted]--he owned Jefferson Machine. He went to jail, and so did [redacted]--the rest of them plea bargained

D [redacted] Was that [redacted] only brush with the law?

S [redacted] [redacted] is remarried, and works for [redacted] cleaners in Dubois--at least that is the last place I know he worked. [redacted] [redacted] with the owner of [redacted] cleaners

D [redacted] I heard [redacted] moved to Arizona

S [redacted] yes, [redacted] got rid of Lynda,

S [redacted] I don't know, but I could find out.

D [redacted] Over the years was Lynda able to maintain close ties with her family, [redacted], [redacted], relatives?

D [redacted] Or did they distance themselves from her too?

S [redacted] no, not really--she stole from them too, and they more or less washed their hands of her--she stole from her grandma too

D [redacted] All for drugs or for some other psychological reason?

S [redacted] she is just a thief--she was in a car accident--had her grandma with her--stole money from her gram's purse at the hospital--gram got a [redacted] settlement after that

D [redacted] Settlement from who??

S [redacted] Lynda's car insurance--that was in 1990 I do believe--I was with Lynda [redacted]

D [redacted] Are you saying Lynda was driving the car?

S [redacted] yes--gram was in the back seat

D [redacted] Since Lynda's parents were both deceased in 1990, and I assume the grandmother has since passed, who did the grandmother leave the estate to?

S [redacted] gram moved to York with Lynda's [redacted]--but, I do believe Lynda's aunt [redacted] got part of the inheritance

S [redacted] Ann is my [redacted]

D [redacted] Wow, you really do know this family....

S [redacted] my husband is going to call me tomorrow night--I can ask him to ask [redacted] where Lynda is

D [redacted] I know exactly where Lynda is...

D [redacted] She is in jail

S [redacted] what happen now

D [redacted] Should be no surprise to you.... knowing her as well as you do. Fraud forger, paper crimes....

D [redacted] Drugs as well.

D [redacted] Credit card schemes, bank fraud, you name it.

S [redacted] I feel sorry for her--she should have gotten help a long time ago--

that's just some of the same stuff as before

S [redacted] where is she in jail at??

D [redacted] It is amazing how she elicits that response from people... they feel sorry for her... She is incarcerated in Philadelphia.

S [redacted] she is mentally ill--they should have locked her up a long time ago

D [redacted] Would you say people would consider her to be dangerous or violent... Would you say there are people out there who are afraid of her?

S [redacted] we live in a small town here--everyone knows everybody--and their business--

you just never know what Lynda will do next. no one here had to worry about her--she really had no friend--she took advantage of everyone--so we all steered clear of her--her own family were victims

D [redacted] I see. I do know that she maintained a friendship with someone I have a feeling you know..

D [redacted] Do you know A [redacted] H [redacted]?

S [redacted] call her sister [redacted]--ask her if she knows Lynda is in jail

S [redacted] did that girl just die?

D [redacted] I don't have to. I know for a fact that Lynda is in jail now. // Are you asking did A [redacted] just die??

S [redacted] yes

D [redacted] I wouldn't know that.. I know she was alive about a year and a half ago... What have you heard?

D [redacted] (Married to T [redacted] H [redacted])

S [redacted] I know you know Lynda is in jail--call [redacted]

S [redacted] there was a a h [redacted] girl that just died a few weeks ago--I am thinking that was her name

D [redacted] Oh, I see... I was always a little reluctant to call [redacted].. I didn't know what kind of person she was. Maybe she was like Lynda.. I know nothing of B [redacted] other than that she is Lynda's sister.

D [redacted] A [redacted] had a daughter named C [redacted]

S [redacted] b [redacted] is a wonderful person--so is d [redacted]

S [redacted] d [redacted] is now married to [redacted]

D [redacted] That is good to know.... but they gave up on Lynda... Not that they had any choice I suppose.

D [redacted] Do you recall--over the years--did Lynda have any "relationships" with anyone other than T [redacted]?

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“She stole from them [*her family*] too, and they [*her family*] more or less washed their hands of her – she stole from her grandma too”

“She is just a thief”

“She was in a car accident – had her grandma with her – stole money from her gram’s purse at the hospital”

“She should have gotten help a long time ago”

“She is mentally ill”

“You just never know what Lynda will do next...She took advantage of everyone – so we all steered clear of her – her own family were victims”

S: both of them didn't want to be associated with her anymore--she ruined the family name--the whole family had to move out of town after the incident

D: That's terrible..... The incident was in the early 80's?

S: Lynda and T started dating in high school-- he was the only one i knew of till they got divorced

S: incident was 84-85

D: Do you know when they got divorced?

S: [redacted]

D: [redacted]

S: they use to live in treasure lake in dubois

D: But when did Lynda and T stop having anything to do with each other?

S: yes, by the time everything went down with [redacted] it was probably the late [redacted]

D: Are you sure they were divorced and not separated?

S: i moved back here from [redacted]

S: i just know they werent together

S: that was around the same time she got caught stealing drugs at dubois hospital

D: I see. So that would mean that Lynda wouldnt have been a resident of Treasure Lake I would assume... / (I mean after they divorced)

S: i know she was still in dubois, but i don't think treasure lake- it costs quite a bit to maintain a home in there

D: Lynda was working in the hospital when she got into trouble stealing the drugs?

S: t lost everything, he had to pay [redacted] back a bunch of money-i think that is why lynda left him--he didn't have any money

D: I see.... What would you say her mental illness actually is?

S: yes- first the catholic hospital, then maple avenue hospital--we couldn't believe she would get another job, at another hospital

D: She seems to lack a conscience.

S: i really don't know--but men [redacted] for her.

yes, she feels no remorse

D: Are you aware of any incident that involved a local pastor?

S: while she is stealing from one person, she is trying to work a plan for the next person. everyone held on to their purses when she was around.

D: So there are a number of people who have horror stories about her..

S: yes, father [redacted] he left here and went to [redacted]

D: What was the incident?

S: yes, that is why lynda never came back here--everyone knew her

D: What happened with fr. [redacted] that involved Lynda?

S: i am trying to remember about her and the priest-- [redacted]

D: I see.. Any recollections about fr. Gregory Kirsch?

S: it took a while for the story to come out about her and the priest, so i don't remember when it was

S: i remember fr.greg-he came here when i came back from [redacted]--he was very young, and very handsome--all the girls loved him

D: Do you think it's a true story? [redacted] And yes... I heard that Fr. Kirsch was a favorite. But are you aware of any scandle between Lynda and Fr. Kirsch?

S: he wasnt here that long- i will have to ask my [redacted] v- she is lynda's [redacted] she knows everything, and i am sure if it involved lynda, she will remember

D: That would be wonderful of you if you would..... I am very grateful to you for taking the time and talking to me.... I cant tell you how much I appreciate this.

S: tell me what you want me to find out--i will ask-with out telling why ,about lynda

D: That would be very helpful if you would be discreet about this..... I will fomulate some questions over the next day or so and e-mail them to you if that's ok.

S: i am usually on the computer around 11:30pm-usually for at least 1 hour. IM me when you see me on here, and i will tell you what i have found out

D: I will..... See if you can recall any stories about Fr. Kirsch.

D: Got time for one more question?

S: or give me your e-mail address and i will send it-- sure

D: Just e-mail me at this screen name, [redacted] Do you recall any rumors surrounding Lynda and a possible "relationship" with a local State Trooper?

S: my [redacted] will tell me all the details, or my [redacted]--that is our church

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“She ruined the family name – the whole family had to move out of town”

“She got caught stealing drugs at Dubois Hospital”

“Everyone held on to their purses when she was around”

D: SSSCD?

S: my [redacted] worked at the police station too!!!!

yes-sscd

D: At troop c?

S: was the cop frank muto?

D: Not to my knowledge.. Want to take another guess?

S: i cant remember—but like i said-my [redacted] will know this too

D: OK heres the hint anyway - initials MC

S: max camp?????

S: i use to [redacted]

D: GET OUT OF HERE

D: really?

D: Isn't he a little old for you?

S: you sure picked the right person to ask these questions

D: Tell me about it... I don't want to stop.

S: [redacted] max back in 75--when i first [redacted]

D: But that would make him 15 years older give or take...

D: Is that right?

S: i just saw him a couple weeks ago--his wife cheryl is still [redacted]

S: i just had my [redacted] birthday on monday

D: Happy birthday... was Max single at the time (in [redacted])

S: yes,

D: Max knows lynda, correct?

S: i really like him too--

S: everyone knows lynda--this is a small town--especially the cops!!!!

D: I suppose. Max is about 60 now?

D: Is he still working or retired now?

S: right around there-- he had a heart attack a few years ago, retired- looks terrible

D: [redacted]

S: no--his wife is a school teacher--in pa--school teacher, and state cops have the highest paying jobs

D: Any scandle ever touch Max?

S: he has kids too-- [redacted]

D: Heather and Chantelle?

S: i dont know for sure--i have been in [redacted] [redacted]--he was in the police car--at burger king about 3 years ago--so it is since then that he has retired

S: how do you know about max's kids

D: I see. // It's a long story but it has to do with a very sophisticated scam Lynda pulled which ensnared [redacted] and in which she relayed information about Max...

S: i have a state cop friend, that i can ask him about max--he would never say anything--i will just say i am curious about it

S: does max know about her giving info about him?

D: Dont put too much out there, OK/// yes he does.

S: when did this happen--recently?

S: call max too--he lives in [redacted] Pa

D: The bulk of the stuff that happened was between [redacted]. Some stuff happened after [redacted] though.

D: No, it wouldn't be a good idea for me to have contact with max.

S: i will find out--the cop is bob petrosky--he is retired--is was a detective

D: [redacted]

D: Back to Lynda for a second. Do you think [redacted] was ever physically abusive to her? In fact do you think anyone has ever been physically abusive to her, as a kid or young girl? Her father maybe or uncles?

S: [redacted]

S: [redacted]

D: I see... Would you be suprised if Lynda knew where max lived?

S: [redacted] lynda comes from a very good family--her parents were wonderful

S: just about everyone knows where max lives

D: Oh, i see, (about Max.) My research shows that Lyndas mother died first... in 1984. Then Donald in 1987.

S: lynda's brother and sister are nothing like lynda--they would never be involved with any thing like what lynda has done.

S: [redacted]

D: I am positive, actually about when her parents died.

D: Did Lynda ever have a miscarriage?

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“Everyone knows Lynda – this is a small town – especially the cops!!”

S: her mom was running for tax collector years back--everyone loved her

S: i don't recall a miscarriage

D: Or a child that died?

S: no child died i am sure

D: Even an infant, say, at one month of age? Would you know?

S: t. aunt b. d. was [redacted] -we would have heard if lynda had a baby that died

S: i will find out about a baby

D: OK, I'm just following up on fragments of stories - mostly misinformation that was given by Lynda...

S: oh yes, lynda lies too!!!

D: Would you like to hear another interesting fact about our little friend?

S: oh yes

D: In June 2000 Lynda escaped from Jail.

S: [redacted]

S: so is she still on the run, or now in jail

D: [redacted]

D: She was caught in November.

S: where was she

D: So she's back incarcerated again. Now facing charges of escape.

D: She was living in a section 8 residence in Johnstown.

S: she hasn't had her kids with her for awhile--has she?

S: didn't t. get them years ago?

D: No... I understand that Mel [redacted] has written her off as dead..... and Les [redacted] the younger one does stay in contact.... And yes, T. has had physical custody for a while.

D: Do you know the people Lynda was caring for (home care) who she stole their drugs from? I mean, if I ever wanted to contact them?

D: Still there?

S: no, no one mentioned names-it was her relatives that told the story--i don't think they knew any of the names. just after she got fired from both hospitals-she went to--i am not sure of this--but saint mary's, Pa. and worked at home health care--i know it was north of here

S: yes i am writing

D: I see. Listen, I've abused you time enough for one night....

S: it may have been ridgeway. my [redacted] at the state police in ridgeway now

S: i have enjoyed this--i will get you some info as soon as possible--i am curious now

S: talk to you soon--good luck

good night

D:but I keep having questions..... last one I promise..... do you think or have you heard whether Lynda ever did any [redacted] the police?

S: i will ask bob petrosky--he loves me, he will tell me.

D: OK... I am sure people will want to know why you are asking....

S: no, i know how to go about this--i am a [redacted]

D: I'd rather be anonymous in this if at all possible.

S: oh, i won't even mention this conversation--and i don't know who you are anyway--right?

D: Really? I may be looking for a good lawyer in your neck of the woods one of these days. Maybe you'll have a referral.

D: May I ask your first name?

S: my favorite attorney--jeff lundy is running for judge--i was out with him and his wife tonight--that is why i am on here so late

i am [redacted]

S: are you really [redacted]

D: Isn't he with the DA's office? Yes I am really [redacted]... I promise.

S: not any more i don't think--i will find out

S: he [redacted] with me

D: Well, thanks [redacted]. I seemed to have hit the jackpot with you... am extremely grateful for your help... I'll let you go... Talk with you soon..... OK?

S: so did his wife, jackie--their daughter was my [redacted]

S: ok, good night

D: OK... thanks again.. good night..... bye

S: bye

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“Oh yes, Lynda lies too!!!”

D: Hi [redacted]... I'm still [redacted] the information you gave me last night... [redacted]

S: hi [redacted]

D: I came up with a few follow-up questions I was just working on.

S: i talked to [redacted] tonight and asked him if [redacted] told him that lynda is in jail. he said no, but he is going to ask [redacted] -i told him i heard it and wanted to know if it was true- he said he will ask

S: i was out to a [redacted] last night, so he didn't even ask me who told me.

D: I see.. it doesn't surprise me that [redacted] wouldn't know this... since there was virtually no contact. /// Good,... for right now, if i can do this without drawing too much attention... it would be great.

S: i will try to help as much as i can-[redacted]

D: [redacted] helping me [redacted]

S: I mean, i know in some context this whole thing must seem a little [redacted] to you...

D: whole

S: yes it does-[redacted] lynda

S: are you from dubois--originally

D: I am from [redacted] living in [redacted] Lynda targeted me for her scam.. He got to me through the internet..

D: She

D: at first... then the scam went beyond the internet... and i came to [redacted]. That's when all hell broke loose.

S: i dont talk to people i dont know--only friends on IM

[redacted] you are the only person i talked to that i didnt know--just to stay away from scams

D: Well, overall i think the internet is probably safe, but there are predators out there, like Lynda... her kind of predator knows how to get past most peoples defense systems..

S: she is sly

Dubois Curious: yes..... few people know exactly what she is capable of...

S: she is use to getting what she wants--one way or another, and she doesn't care who she hurts. (like her kids, her family)

D: She is a frightening, frightening woman.

D: What amazes me is that she has evaded incarceration for all these years given all the criminal stuff she has done:

S: she stole from her grandmother after she wrecked her car--in the hospital--that tells you what kind of a person she is

Dubois Curious: What did she steal, money from her purse? Or narcotics that were supposed to be for granny to lessen her pain from the accident?

S: i think everyone feels sorry for her--one way or another, and you have to press charges for her to go to jail--that is why she has so many sob stories

D: So all the people she harmed didn't press charges beause they felt sorry for her?

S: lynda wasn't hurt as bad as her gram--gram broke her hip--lynda went with her to the hospital with her and her aunt ann, in the ambulance. lynda held their purses while they were being examined. gram had \$20 in her purse before lynda held it--then she blamed her aunt ann for stealing it--so aunt ann isn't real fond of her because of it--of course gram knew lynda took it

S: when she told you her sob stories, did you believe them?? she has a way about her to con people

D: Very typical of Lynda. That's her MO. blame someone else.

D: And yes. I believed her stories.

S: she always will--she is always the victim

D: To a certain extent..... YES..... she portrays herself as being victimized.....

D: It's a conving act in some ways... even if you dont believe it, you believe it.

D: She's that good.

S: that is why lynda left town--finally--everyone knew about her, and she couldnt tell her stories to anyone here

D: It would seem Dubois isnt far enough away.

S: there are at least twice as many people there, i lived her since i was [redacted]--except for about [redacted] years, and not all at once--and i dont know everyone in dubois

D: Well, you know her.

D: (But I know what you mean...)

S: if you mention lynda kern or femichio in this town, everyones ears perk up--what is she up to now?--since [redacted] she is a legend in this town.

D: Yeah, the [redacted] thing, i'm hoping that you will be able to clarify some of that for me (some other time).

D: Do yo know Lynda lived in Purx sy for almost three months in the summer of '97?

S: i will have to ask a few questions about that too.

S: no i didnt, i was in [redacted] then

D: It seems like its a complex and interesting story (the [redacted] thing). // Yes, she lived at 212 Mahoning street.

D: West

D: She committed a few crimes during that brief time there..

S: that is, i do believe, right by subway

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“She is sly”

D: Thanks, that would be great.....//

D: Is that ann molinaro?

S: yes, her son joe

D: [redacted]

D: Punxsy sure is a cozy little hamlet.

S: i think he has a little bit of that [redacted]-ha ha

S: everyone knows everyone elses business in this town

D: I dont know anything about him.... I know there are alot of Kems in Punxsy.

S: yes, but they arent all related

D: [redacted] Punxsy based law firms?

S: martha and ann have different mothers-gram is ann's stepmother. martha was her real daughter-but have same dad- his last name was nichols, ann has a brother, john-he changed his last name to miklos- and a brother in bamsboro, Pa.

S: no i havent worked since [redacted]-i am too busy now. i have a friend in law school in pittsburgh, [redacted]

D: Oh, that is interesting.... [redacted] family tree research [redacted] when I ran into the nichols / Michlos names...

D: So Francis Molinaro is [redacted]

S: ann molinaro's mother was a dubensky-her mom [redacted]

S: he is on the town counsel. he is retired air force

D: [redacted] He would be Lynda's uncle? [redacted]

S: francis is not related to her-his brother is johnny-who is married to ann-martha's sister

D: OK.. got it... I wonder if Lynda ever tried to get his influence or his connections to help her out in some way.

S: ann has a brother in bamesboro, Pa-i am trying to think of his name

D: Just thinking out loud....

S: I am sure francis is a little too smart to even want to be involved in anyway with lynda

D: I agree.... I'm wondering - can you recall a time when you knew Lynda to be ... for lack of a better word normal? I mean do you have recollections of [redacted] her [redacted] and thought there was nothing odd about her?

S: she use to be friends with [redacted], in high school-she wasn't too bad then. I cant pin point when she went over the edge

D: I do believe that after Martha died something in Lynda did snap, but I'm trying to kinda fine tune at what point in life she started becoming bizare..... I have to beloeve it predates Marthas passing.

S: I think it was after she had her first baby

D: Well, her first baby was born years before Martha died....

S: I know-martha was a wonderful person-i am sure she didnt want to think there was anything wrong with her daughter

S: I know lynda lied a lot-about everything

D: Right..... but she must have know Lynda wasn't "right" in the head. I mean, she was her mother... Maybe Lynda flipped when Martha died because Martha may have been "the only one who understands" Lynda. You know... forgiving..... Unconditional love....

S: I know after martha died-there was an incident at the house, but i cant remember exactly what-i remember something about her stealing stuff from the house-she broke in-i know that is when [redacted] and her had it out-i will find out about it-[redacted] use to live right by her on lane ave.

D: Yes... any stories that are true about her, are very helpful to me.... Are you fairly certain that Lynda was [redacted]

S: I wish i could have talked to you before [redacted] last night - [redacted] was there. she could have told me about lynda's early days

S: yes i am sure-her sister [redacted] and her look almost identic al-[redacted] is around 54

S: now [redacted] is the one that doesnt look like them

D: That would have been great but as it is I'm [redacted] how old is [redacted] now?

S: early 40's

D: I dont think it's possible that [redacted]... the math seems wrong... let me think...

Injured in the accident were Fernichio and two passengers in her car, Anna Nichles, 84, and Anna Molinaro, 67, both of Punxsutawney. Police said all three were taken to the Indiana Hospital where Fernichio and Molinaro were treated and released. Nickles was transferred to the DuBois Regional Medical Center where she is listed in satisfactory condition today.

Police said the Fernichio car hit a utility pole after hitting the truck. Crews from Rural Electric and Bell of Pennsylvania had to be called to repair the lines and the pole following the accident.

On June 10, 1992, Clearfield Borough Police Department received information from Duane Kephart of Clearfield Hospital Security to meet with him and other personnel of the Clearfield Hospital to discuss the theft of controlled substances from various locations in the hospital. After receiving this call, Chief Wisor and this officer met with Mr. Bill Baker (Risk Management), William Galarneau (Pharmacist), Elsie Reichard (Nursing Director) and Duane Kephart, to discuss this incident.

William Galarneau explained that after checking their records, a number of carpjects (a syringe-like housing, manufactured by Winthrop Pharmaceuticals, Division of Sterling Drugs Inc., New York, N.Y. 10016) of Demerol, a Schedule II Narcotic Controlled substance, were missing from four different locations in the hospital. (Note: Demerol is Meperidine Hydrochloride, - ethyl 1-methyl-4-phenylisonpecotate hydrochloride). Mr. Galarneau explained hospital procedures, record keeping of controlled substances, etc. In checking the "Clearfield Hospital Controlled Drug Distribution Record - 24 Hour Nursing Audit" sheet, Mr. Galarneau noticed several discrepancies in the narcotics count, dealing with starting and ending inventories, several numbers that appeared to have been altered or changed, and learned from others, that some of the signatures on the sheet may have been forged. The discrepancies in the Demerol counts came from various narcotics cabinet locations on several different floors at the hospital. The demerol is accessible to hospital personnel qualified to administer these controlled substances. Mr. Galarneau felt that the theft occurred sometime between 5-26-92 and 6-4-92, with a total of 108 carpjects of demerol missing, in various dosages. The cost to Clearfield Hospital for the demerol varies from 32.3¢ for a 25 Mg. dose to 41.1¢ for a 100 Mg dose. (note: This is only the cost to purchase this substance, and doesn't include, storage, and other record keeping and administration costs involved).

After numerous interviews with hospital personnel, this officer learned that an individual by the name of Lynda K. Fernichio, the above listed defendant, was recently hired at the Clearfield Hospital, as a nurse. She was employed from 5-11-92 to 6-5-92. Lynda was given medication administration tests on 5-15-92 and 5-18-92. (Note: Passing these allowed a nurse to administer controlled substances to patients). Lynda failed these tests and was advised that she wasn't permitted to pass controlled substances until she achieved competency on the tests.

On 6-4-92, Nancy Snyder, (nurse at Clearfield Hospital) was working the 2nd floor (Telemetry) and was informed by her supervisor (Brenda Galarneau) that Lynda Fernichio was not permitted to pass medications. Lynda asked Nancy Snyder, this date, if she could assist in passing medications. Nancy told Lynda that she could handle the patients that were assigned to her, without help. Later, Lynda decided to lock up her paycheck, and her husband's paycheck in the narcotics cabinet. She obtained the key and opened the cabinet, while Thelma Stratton and Nancy Snyder observed. Nancy Snyder watched, as Lynda Fernichio removed something from the cabinet and put it in her pocket.

PROBABLE CAUSE BELIEF IS BASED ON THE FOLLOWING FACTS AND CIRCUMSTANCES: (see instruc. below)

The paychecks were still in the narcotics cabinet at this time. Lynda then removed the paychecks and placed them in her pocket. Nancy approached Lynda and viewed a box in Lynda's pocket. The box was a ten pack of demerol carpjects, (50 mg. dosages). Nancy Snyder said that Lynda was shaking while she and Thelma Stratton approached her. A few minutes later, Lynda said that she was upset because she had been fighting with her husband. She left the hospital floor, asking to have dinner with her husband at 5:15 P.M. Lynda left the floor and returned later. After returning back to the floor, Lynda was seen leaving the medication room with a newspaper under her arm. Later, personnel discovered that the "Clearfield Hospital Controlled Drug Distribution Record and 24 Hour Nursing Audit" sheet was missing from this room. A supervisor was contacted about 6:30 P.M. and the supervisor requested that all nurses remain on the floor until a complete audit could be taken of the controlled substances. Lynda left the floor.

On 7-22-92, at 9:10 A.M., Lynda Fernichio, the above listed defendant, arrived at the Clearfield Borough Police Department to discuss this incident. Note: This officer set up a date and time for this interview with Lynda, prior to this meeting. Lynda was advised of her constitutional warnings. She agreed to talk to this officer, without an attorney present, concerning this incident. During the interview, Lynda admitted that she took ten - 50 MG. carpjects of demerol from Telemetry on 6-4-92. She stated that she didn't think that she took all of the 108 carpjects of demerol that were reported missing. Lynda told this officer that her problem with demerol began about 4 1/2 years ago, when she started having migraine headaches. She said that she was prescribed demerol on numerous occasions at hospital emergency rooms, and became addicted to this drug.

Based on the above information received, investigation made, observations, statements obtained, interviews, etc., all of which this officer believes to be true and correct, charges the above list-defendant, Lynda Fernichio, with: **THEFT BY UNLAWFUL TAKING OR DISPOSITION**, Sec. 3921 (a), **RECEIVING STOLEN PROPERTY**, Sec. 3925 and **POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE**, Sec. 13 (a), clause 16. Note: **THEFT BY UNLAWFUL TAKING OR DISPOSITION** and **RECEIVING STOLEN PROPERTY** are violations of Title 18, Pa. Crimes Code, as amended, and are graded as M-3 gradings. **POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE**, is a violation of Act 64, The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device, and Cosmetic Act of April 14, 1972, and is graded as a misdemeanor charge.
