08/10/2010 Initial Officer Thomas Dowdell 19

This Officer was advised to contact Linda Kerr regarding a "Criminal Mischief" complaint. I called Ms. Kerr, at which time she advised me that someone had broken into her apartment and sprayed all of her furniture and bedding with some type of pesticide. Ms. Kerr stated that she arrived home at approximately 19:10 hours this date and could smell a strong odor of a pesticide inside her apartment. She then advised that she "saved her bed," but had to throw away her loveseat. This Officer asked Ms. Kerr why she waited so long to call the police, and she stated that she had to clean up first and then it began to bother her, so she decided to call. This Officer asked Ms. Kerr if her door had been locked when she arrived home on 08-09-2010, and she said it was and she has no idea how someone got into her apartment. This Officer advised Ms. Kerr to contact the Apartment's superintendent in the morning to let him know about the odor.

08/10/2010 Followup Officer James Stutzman 24

This Officer returned a call to Linda Kerr at 0835 hrs. in reference to the prior incident she had reported to OFC Dowdell. Ms. Kerr said she would prepare a list of her damaged property, along with a suspect list, and would meet with OFC Dowdell after 0001 hrs. on 8-11-10.

OFC SAFETY NOTE:

Linda Kerr did express to this OFC that she put a butter knife into her pocket in the event she encountered a suspect at her residence. This OFC did speak to Ms. Kerr regarding carrying a weapon and further advised her not to confront a suspect, but to call 911 so that the Police could handle the matter.

08/10/2010 Followup Sgt. Edward Fisher 21

At approximately 1625 hrs. this date, the Police Secretary advised me that Linda Kerr was on the phone regarding an incident that Officer Dowdell handled early this morning. The Police Secretary advised that the woman wanted an Officer now, but said it was difficult to understand exactly what the problem was. Upon speaking with Ms Kerr, she began the conversation by talking about Magistrate Grecek and a harassment case involving the woman who is spraying chemicals in her apartment. When I asked her to slow down as she wasn't making much sense, the female began to explain how her apartment had been broken into and chemicals sprayed, which damaged her couch and other items. I was now reviewing Officer Dowdell's report, but the things Ms. Kerr was now saying didn't match what she had told Officer Dowdell earlier. When I questioned her about the discrepancies, she denied telling Officer Dowdell some of those things. I then asked her what she was calling about now, and she stated that the female was back again and was spraying her windows and they are now all soaked with some type of chemical. I asked Ms. Kerr if she could see the female and she replied yes.

Officer Crichton and I responded straight to Ms. Kerr's apartment, but did not see anyone around spraying anything. Upon walking into her building, this Officer encountered an elderly female sitting on a lawn chair in front of the building and asked if she had seen anyone around spraying anything, and she replied "no". This Officer then encountered another elderly female walking around the building carrying a lawn chair and asked her the same question, and I again received the same answer. Officers then went to Ms. Kerr's apartment and spoke with her. She was now saying that the female was standing over by the wall (Hardware), which is approximately 40 yards away. She said the female had a wand and was spraying something into her apartment. Officer Crichton went outside to check and found that the grass was not wet. He did find a small splatter of a sticky substance on Ms. Kerr's window. This substance had no odor and looked more like something had fallen and splashed there some time ago. When asked if she could explain our findings, Ms Kerr stated that the female must have left. Ms. Kerr then kept going back to the original incident that she reported to Officer Dowdell. Ms Kerr was advised that if the female returned again and began to spray her apartment and she saw her doing that, she should immediately call 911. Ms Kerr did refuse to speak with anyone from Crisis or to accept any mental health intervention at this time.

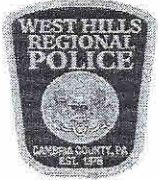

08/12/2010 Initial Sgt. Edward Fisher 21

Mr. Podrasky stated that he rented an apartment to a female named Linda Kerr, and when he did a background check on her, nothing of any significance stood out, but now he is a little concerned. Mr. Podrasky stated that Ms. Kerr filed a report with the Police the other day about a female breaking into her apartment and spraying a pesticide or some other type of chemical around, which resulted in damage to her furniture, (Refer to Inc. #10-03029). Mr. Podrasky said, this morning, he observed Ms. Kerr walking around the Complex and ducking into bushes. She told him she was attempting to catch the female responsible for the spraying of her apartment. Mr. Podrasky wanted to know what could be done because he feels Ms. Kerr is suffering from some type of psychiatric problem. I advised Mr. Podrasky that I spoke with Ms. Kerr on a follow up to her original report the other day and asked her if she was interested in speaking with someone or going to the hospital, and she declined. I also advised Mr. Podrasky that even though Ms. Kerr's behavior may be bizzare, it is not criminal, and unless she is posing a threat to herself or to others, the Police could not force her into any type of intervention. Mr. Podrasky then advised me that he heard from another tenant that Ms. Kerr was to have been carrying a butcher knife around with her the other day and stabbing it into the ground, but the tenant didn't want to get involved, so he/she didn't call the Police. I advised Mr. Podrasky that the tenant should have called the Police at that time or come forward to report the incident. I told him that, at this time, that information is hearsay. I advised Mr. Podrasky that I would keep an eye out for Ms. Kerr today and if he observed any strange behavior, he should call Immediately and not after the fact.

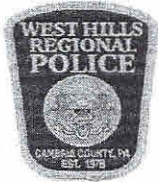

08/12/2010 Initial Sgt. Edward Fisher 21

At approximately 1127 hrs., this Officer met Julie from Crisis at the Oasis Car Wash and gave her a brief description of the events and complaints received regarding the actions of Linda Kerr. I then accompanied Julie to Ms. Kerr's residence. Julie spoke with Linda Kerr regarding the reports received by this Department during the past couple of days. While at Ms. Kerr's apartment, Officers detected a strong odor of natural gas in the apartment. It was found that one of the pilot lights on the stove had gone out and was leaking gas. A maintenance man came to the apartment and relit the pilot light. It was also determined that Ms. Kerr had been spraying her apartment with some type of strong deodorizer, as well as an insecticide, on a daily basis. According to the label on one of the bottles, this spray would last for nine months. After Julie evaluated Ms. Kerr, she agreed that there were some issues going on with Ms. Kerr, but not enough for Crisis to take any type of intervention actions at this time. Ms. Kerr was advised to cease prowling around the Cambria Ace Hardware after hours and also not to be out doing surveillance in her neighborhood. She was also advised to stop spraying chemicals around her apartment.

08/12/2010 Followup Sgt. Edward Fisher 21

After returning to the office to put this incident into the computer, the Police Secretary advised me that Linda Kerr was on the phone again reporting that two females were hiding in the trees behind her building and spraying chemicals. She said there was an odor of an insecticide in her apartment again. This Officer spoke with Ms. Kerr on the phone, at which time she stated that she could actually see both women hiding behind the trees by the Hardware. She said one female was wearing a green T-shirt and the other was wearing a white shirt.

While enroute, this Officer requested that 911 contact Crisis and ask Julie to call me on my cell phone. The Police Secretary also called and advised me that Linda Kerr called the office again and asked her to radio me and tell me that the women were hiding in the trees. Julie from Crisis called me as I was pulling onto scene behind the Hardware and stated that Ms. Kerr also called there with the same information I had been given by the Police Secretary. I advised Julie that I was in the area of Ms. Kerr's apartment and there was no one around, except some male who was loading items into his vehicle. Julie advised me to just document the information for now. This Officer then spoke with the male, who was loading his car, and he confirmed that there had been nobody around. While I was speaking with this male, Ms. Kerr yelled out the window for me to check to the left of my location. I then went and spoke with Ms. Kerr and again advised her that there was nobody there and she should stop calling and making false reports to the Police. I advised Ms. Kerr not to call unless there was, in fact, an emergency.

Complainant, Linda Kerr, called the office to advise that there were people putting calking in her heating ducts and on her pipes, along with insecticides. She advised that she spoke with District Justice Gresik in his Court Room, at which time he ordered that these activities stop and advised that the WHRP must enforce his Order. Ms. Kerr was advised to obtain a written copy of Justice Gresik's Order so that this Department could enforce it. She advised that she would contact her attorney and have a copy of the Order sent to this Department. Ms. Kerr said she has called this Department several times in the past, and the Police have done nothing to help her. She said there was a "little, short, pudgy officer," who seemed to understand her situation and even checked for the insecticide. She said he did smell the odor, but also did nothing. Ms. Kerr said she has called the Court Administrator and the State Police to file a complaint against this Department, but because they also would do nothing, she went to District Judge Gresik, who issued the Order. This Officer, again, advised Ms. Kerr to obtain a copy of that Order for this Department and told her the Officers would gladly enforce it.

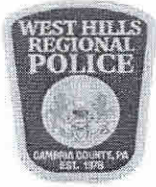

10/06/2010 Initial Officer Dean West 18

On Wednesday, 10-06-2010, at or about 0904hrs., Cambria 911 advised this Officer to meet Alan Podrasky, the Norwood Gardens Apartment Property Manager, behind Building 7 regarding a female, who had set some papers on fire earlier this morning. Upon arrival, this Officer spoke with Mr. Podrasky, who pointed out a spot just outside Building 7, which was near the rear side door and a tree. On the ground, I observed a small amount of burned ashes from paper. Mr. Podrasky stated that after arriving at work this date, he was contacted by another tenant (Rustina Martin) of Building 7, who stated that at or about 5:30am, she heard noise outside her apartment window and when she looked out, she viewed Lynda Kerr, whom she knows from living in the same Building, burning something. Ms. Kerr was also to be shouting, "it's gonna be worse tomorrow. I'll use kerosene.". Mr. Podrasky stated that he spoke with Ms. Kerr about the happening, but she denied any involvement. This Officer then went down to Ms. Kerr's apartment and found the door wide open, but received no response when I called out to Ms. Kerr. I then walked through the apartment, but did not find Ms. Kerr. We also checked out the other side of the building, with negative results, and then again went back to Ms. Kerr's apartment. As we were leaving the building to get photos of the burned material, Ms. Kerr arrived. I spoke with her again about the reported happening, and she again denied any involvement, stating that she had a guest overnight, who could say that she was not outside. I informed Ms. Kerr that I would follow up on this and if there was enough evidence to show her involvement, she may be cited.

10/06/2010 Followup Officer Dean West 18

This Officer spoke with Beth from "Crisis" regarding Ms. Kerr. Beth stated that she had about an hour long conversation with Ms. Kerr, at which time Ms. Kerr openly admitted to her that she did, in fact, burn the paper outside the building this morning. Beth said Ms. Kerr also made mention about the possibility of going somewhere, and Beth believed that Ms. Kerr might check herself in to be evaluated. I did explain to Beth the entire incident/contact with Ms. Kerr, and Beth said her conversation with Ms. Kerr was similar, but had a few exaggerations.

10/13/2010 Initial Officer Christopher Woodruff 31

On October 13, 2010, at approximately 16:49 hrs., this Officer was dispatched to 709 Edwards Hill Apartments for a Harassment complaint. I arrived on scene and spoke with the victim, Shirley Walling, who stated that Lynda Kerr had called her a "blonde bitch" at approximately 16:45 hrs. this date when she was getting her mail. Ms. Walling stated that this occurred when she was walking into the building and Ms. Kerr's apartment door was open. The victim's daughter, Marsha Walling, advised Lynda Kerr that the doors to the residents' apartments needed to be kept shut. (Note: This is the Apartment's Policy.) Shirley Walling said, at that point, a friend of Linda Kerr, who is known to her as Nick, stated, "We will leave the doors open if we want." Ms. Kerr then came out of her apartment and called Shirley Walling "a blonde bitch" and further stated that she is "always sleeping around." Shirley Walling stated that this type of incident occurs on a daily basis, and she has reported it to the landlord several times. Shirley Walling stated that this has been an ongoing problem for more than a month now. Shirley Walling stated that Linda Kerr will walk up and down the hall near her door and start talking about her, calling her, "the blonde bitch." Shirley Walling advised that there are witnesses to today's events and to events that occurred in the past, and they are willing to testify if Linda Kerr is cited. Shirley Walling stated that Lynda Kerr has called her "a blonde bitch" approximately 20 to 30 times in the past month, and she has just let it go. She said, however, this is now starting to bother her. At this time, this Officer went to speak with Ms. Kerr, and she stated that she did not call Ms. Walling "a blonde bitch," but did call her a "a nibby-nose neighbor." Ms. Kerr stated that her friend, Nick, was there, but left before the police arrived. This Officer advised Ms. Kerr that she would be receiving a Non-Traffic Citation in the mail for Harassment and that she needs to leave Ms. Walling and her other neighbors alone, and if she continues to harass them, more Citations would be issued.

03/31/2011 **Initial** **Sgt. Edward Fisher 21**

Officers were dispatched for a "Burglary Completed" at 770 Goucher Street, Apt. #1, in Southmont Borough. Arriving on scene, Officers met the Victim/Complainant, Linda Kerr, in her second-floor apartment. Ms. Kerr stated that she left the house at approximately 12:30 p.m. with her Caseworker for an appointment at Nulton Diagnostics and arrived home approximately 15 minutes prior to the arrival of Officers. She said when she arrived home, she found that unknown actor(s) had entered her apartment and scattered her DVDs and CDs around the living room area. Ms. Kerr stated that it would be her estimate that approximately 25 DVDs and 20 CDs were missing. They were to be by various artists, but most being Frank Sinatra and Tom Jones. The actor(s) also threw toilet paper around the living room area, trailing it to the bedroom area. Ms. Kerr's clothing was also ransacked and thrown about the bathroom floor. Officers noticed that three slats from the window blinds had been torn down and the window was open. Ms. Kerr claimed that she was sure the window had been closed. Ms. Kerr also showed Officers gouges in the hardwood floor and marks on the kitchen wall from a blue marker. Det. Sgt. Musulin examined the door and it appeared that the actor(s) slid a sharp object between the wood trim on the door to force the doorknob lock open, which left a small scratch on the door latch. Ms. Kerr stated that she did not have the deadbolt secured as she gets confused about how to lock it. The door also had a padlock latch mounted on the outside, but that was also not utilized. While examining and photographing the door locks, this Officer noticed that the entrance to Apartment 1A was in very close proximity to Ms. Kerr's apartment, and I asked who lived there. Ms. Kerr stated that she did not know that person's name as he had just moved into the apartment, but she said he was "a very strange guy." Det. Sgt. Musulin pounded on the door of Apt. 1A in an attempt to see if the resident heard anything, but his knock was not answered. As Officers were leaving the building, this Officer checked the mailboxes for the name of the occupant of Apartment 1A, but there was no name on the box. However, there was a piece of mail sticking out of the box, on which the name of Michael Santichen was observed.

04/04/2011 **Followup** **Sgt. Edward Fisher 21**

This Officer assisted Det. Sgt. Musulin as needed with interviews of Nick Coslin and Linda Kerr relative to the Burglary reported by Ms. Kerr. Based upon interviews conducted with neighbors of Linda Kerr, Det. Sgt. Musulin determined that Linda Kerr was responsible for the theft of several of the neighbors' packages, along with possible criminal mischief incidents to vehicles around Ms. Kerr's building. Linda Kerr was advised of her Rights and a Notifications of Rights was signed by her. Ms. Kerr did admit to filing a false report to Det. Sgt. Musulin regarding her claim of a Burglary and did provide a written confession admitting to this, as well as to the theft of packages that belonged to her neighbors, but she denied any involvement in the criminal mischief reports of damage to vehicles. Charges are pending in this incident.

05/18/2011 **Followup** **Sgt. Edward Fisher 21**

This Officer and Det. Sgt. Musulin attended a Preliminary Hearing this date for charges filed against Linda Kerr, who was represented by Public Defender Lovette. The case was waived to Cambria County Court.

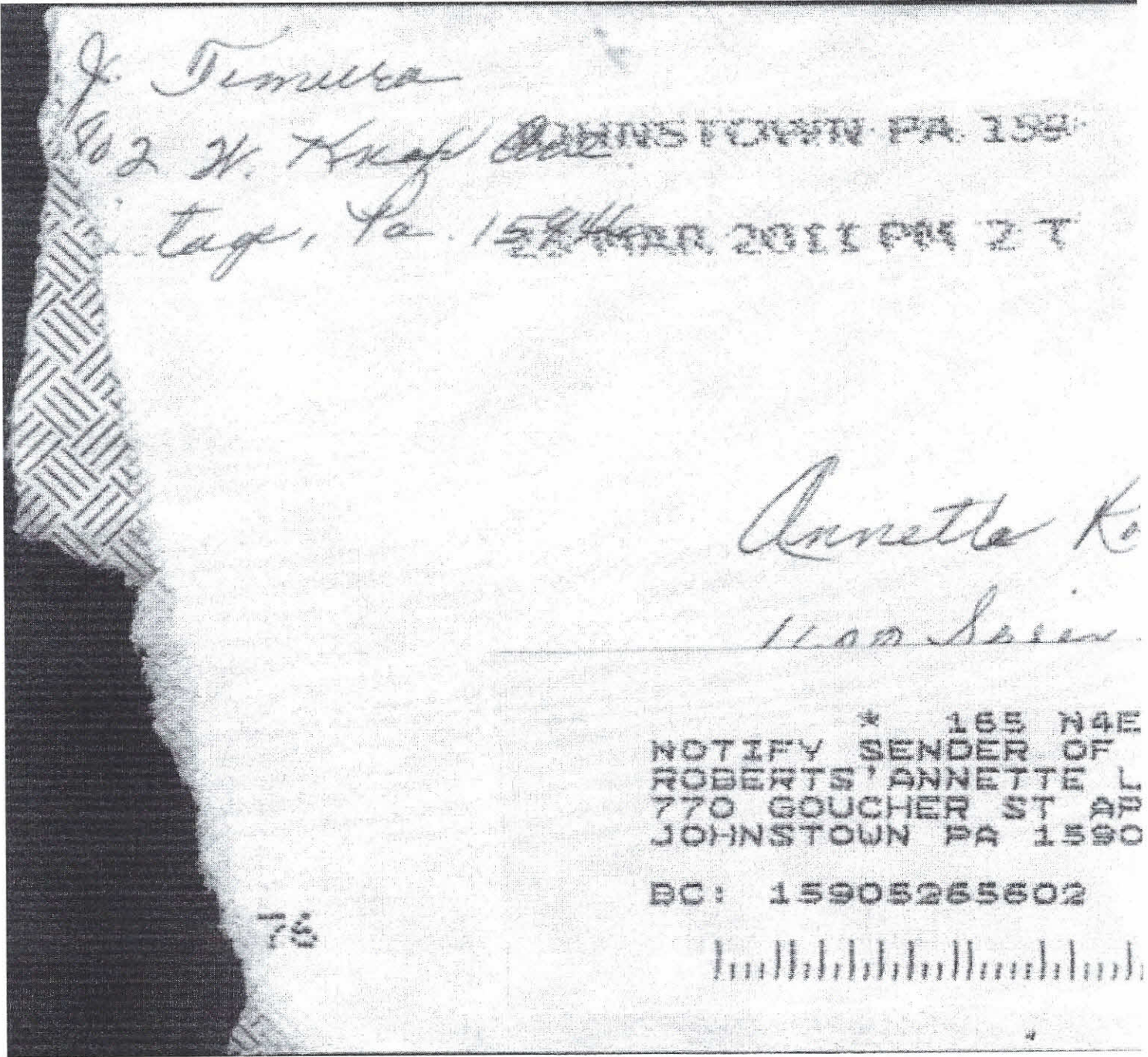

AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE

On or about Thursday March 31st, 2011 at approx. 15:30 hrs. West Hills Regional Police were dispatched to 770 Goucher St. apt. #1 resulting from a reported burglary at said location. Upon arrival on scene both affiants were met by the now defendant, who advised affiants that an unknown person, or persons had entered her residence and stole a quantity of her Tom Jones C.D's. The now defendant further stated that the unknown actor/s did remove all her clothing from the shelves in her bathroom area, located off of her bedroom. As the affiants proceeded to examine the crime scene, the now defendant did point out toilet tissue being drapped throughout her apartment, along with blue magic marker scribbings on her wall in the kitchen, as well as ceramic tile being pried off the kitchen walls in various locations, along with the hardwood floor in the living room area being pried up at several different locations.

"Strange things" happen when Lynda Kerr is near.

On April 1st, 2011 at approx. 18:40 hrs. Sgt. Musulin conducted an interview with a tenant who resides at 770 Goucher St. in a nearby apartment to the defendant, who wishes to be anonymous, and is in fear of retaliation; said tenant advised Sgt. Musulin that within the past three weeks since the defendant had moved to apartment #1 at above said location, strange things began to occur specifically her mail being tampered with and opened and then returned several days later with a bogus explanation. A source further stated that another tenants packages had been stolen and then opened and then returned in several days to a second tenant who was also interviewed and also wishes to remain anonymous.

With receipt of above said information obtained from two tenants who were interviewed by Sgt. Musulin, an interview was set up with the defendant on or about April 4th, 2011 at approx. 19:10 hrs. at which time the defendant was advised of her constitutional rights, and a rights waiver was executed at which time Sgt. Musulin proceeded to interview the defendant who did in fact confess to falsely reporting a burglary at her residence and further did provide details that only the perpetrator would know specifically admitting to prying up the hardwood floor with a butter knife.

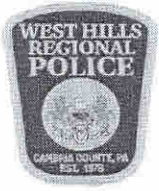

It was also learned that this set of stairs is used by Jennifer Manges and her seeing-eye dog to access the outside of the building and the parking area used by the vehicles that transport Jennifer Manges. The piece of concrete with the rebar sticking out was removed by the witness prior to Jennifer Manges and her seeing-eye dog using the steps. It was also learned that a shovel was placed in a common walkway inside the building by the Defendant. The shovel was removed prior to either the victim or her seeing-eye dog tripping or being injured by the shovel. The victim did provide a letter that she received from the Defendant. The Defendant did admit to placing the shovel in the common walkway area of the hallway in the letter. The victim stated that she and her seeing-eye dog use these areas on a daily basis to access the inside and outside of the building.

Ms. Kerr then came out of another room and began to question my presence. After seeing the cord, nail and hammer, I informed both subjects that they needed to be more considerate of the times they make noise. While leaving the apartment, I also informed both subjects of the earlier reported incident, which occurred yesterday, and I informed them that they would be receiving Citations for their actions and/or involvement. Ms. Kerr then began a verbal tirade, belittling her neighbors, the police and the landlord. This tirade lasted for approximately 10 minutes and included a phone call to the Cambria 911 Center (answered by A. Lichvar), asking what she needed to do to file a complaint about the "East Hills Police." All of this was heard as Officers remained at the bottom of the stairs and the back of the hallway, hoping that she would come out of her apartment.

Lynda Kerr is making too much noise. The police are called. When they arrive they ask her to "be more considerate of the times they make noise," Lynda began a "verbal tirade belittling her neighbors, the police and the landlord."

THEN, Lynda called 911 to inquire how she might file a complaint against the police!!!!

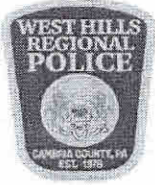
